2019 Food Vendor Application

We are pleased to invite you to participate in the 27th Annual Good in the Hood Multicultural Music & Food Festival on June 22nd and 23rd at King School Park. Food Vendors will be located in the parking lot NECN 4815 NE 7th.

2019 Food Vendor Dates:

Saturday, June 21, Noon - 10:00 PM

Sunday, June 23, Noon – 10:00 PM

Food Vendor	FEES
Single Item Food Vendors (kettle corn, coffee, dessert items, etc.)	\$400 (10'x10' space includes \$50 refundable deposit) Deposit returned based on area being clean
Full Menu Food Vendors (more than one item being sold.)	\$625 (10'x20' space includes \$50 refundable deposit) Deposit returned based on area being clean

Food vendor pricing includes: **one (1) 20 amp/120-volt outlets**, water, trash service, food waste disposal, public seating area, and overnight site security. **There will be a \$50 fee for additional electrical outlets.** Vendors must provide their own tent, cooking accommodations and other enclosures.

The refundable deposit and 1/2 of the required vendor fee must accompany each application if you are paying installments. The balance of the **fee must be paid no later than May 1, 2019.** A food vendor coordinator (or their representative) will inspect your area after the event to check if the area is clean and no items are left behind. The deposit will be fully refunded 10 business days after the event. All fees will be refunded if application is not accepted. **Space will be assigned on a first approved and first full paid basis**

Each vendor must furnish proof of a current Multnomah County temporary Restaurant License or current mobile unit license as well as a general liability insurance. **Multnomah County's temporary Restaurant License is \$110.** For information on how to obtain your license and permit contact: Multnomah County Health Department at (503) 988-3400.

SET-UP DETAILS

Set up will start at 7:00 AM for both Saturday, June 22 and Sunday, June 23. All food vendors must be set up, ready and open to the public by 11:00 AM. Early set up must be approved by the GITH Food Vendor Coordinator. Food vendors will not be allowed to break down early due to safety regulations.

SECURITY

There will be on-site 24-hour security. However, Good in the Hood 501c (3) are not liable for any damage or theft to materials left overnight.

We reserve the right to limit items sold based on duplication of products. Approved items will be listed on your acceptance notification.

We will market to over 30,000 residents living within the Portland Metro Area including Vancouver, Washington. We ask that all vendors help to get the word out through their marketing venues. Flyers and posters will be available for distribution after May 1, 2019 and can be obtained through your GITH representative.
